Chhatapur (Rajeshwari O.P.) P.S. Case No. 44 of 2020 for the

Miscellaneous No.37123 of 2020 and Criminal Miscellaneous

Let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his his arrest/surrender within four weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.C.J.M.-VI, Supaul, in connection with Chhatapur (Rajeshwari O.P.) P.S. Case No. 44 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
