Heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioner
as well as learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing
for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in connection with Raghopur
P. S. Case No.55 of 2019 registered for the offences
punishable under Sections 419, 420, 423 and 120-B of the
I.P.C.

As per the prosecution case, this petitioner has
become one of the bailors in connection with Raghopur P.
S. Case No.100 of 2014, of all accused who at the time of



his apprehension wrongly stated his name to be Mano Sah also concealed his actual identity at that time and this facilitated release of an accused without disclosing his actual identity. It is further alleged that the accused, who were released, are still absconding and have not been apprehended.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that petitioner has become the victim of circumstances and in fact, petitioner never became the bailor of any person in Raghapur P. S. Case No.100 of 2014 rather petitioner became bailor of accused Manoj Rai in Desari P. S. Case No.154 of 2014 on 11.07.2014 and he had submitted the paper of his property to the advocate clerk, but it appears that the same was misused by the said advocate clerk and made him bailor in Raghapur P. S. Case No.100 of 2014. Petitioner has got no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since 26.07.2020

Considering the period of custody coupled with the fact that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of
