Petitioners are in custody in connection with Mokama P.S. Case No. 241 of 2019 for the offence under sections 414 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25(1-B)a 26/35 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in the instant case a stolen motorcycle was recovered from the possession of Ranjit Kumar, a co-accused and nothing was recovered from the possession of this petitioner or from the house of the petitioner.

The petitioners is in custody since 23.10.2019.

Considering the fact that nothing was recovered from



the possession of this petitioner and the petitioner is in custody since 23.10.2019, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioners, let the petitioners, named above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 50,000/- (Fifty thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Barh, Patna, in connection with Mokama P.S. Case No. 241 of 2019.
