Mr. Dronacharya, learned counsel appearing on
behalf of the petitioner on instructions, submits that suspension
of the petitioner has been revoked vide order dated 15.03.2021.
However, he submits that the petitioner has not been paid
subsistence allowance for the period he was put under
suspension.

Considering the fact that the suspension of the
