2 16-11-2021 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Mufassil P.S. Case No. 260 of 2019 for the offence under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 325, 307, 353, 332, 337, 338, 427 and 283 of the Indian Penal Code and under Section 41 and 45 of the B.P.E. Act. Subsequently, section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016 has been added.

Considering the allegation levelled against the petitioners of assaulting the police party and being involved in liquor smuggling, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Accordingly, this anticipatory bail application is dismissed.



The petitioners are directed to surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from today and seek regular bail, if so advised. If they do so, their application for regular bail shall be considered by the learned Court below on its own merit without being prejudiced by this order.
