2 22-02-2021 Heard learned Counsel for the petitioner and the learned
Counsel for the State.

This Court would expect that the petitioner's Counsel would honour his undertaking in the instant proceedings regarding supply of requisite court fee etc. within two weeks from the date he is called upon to do so by the office.

Petitioner seeks bail in Haspura PS Case No. 17 of 2020 registered under Sections 25(1-B)a and 26 of the Arms Act.

Since 22.1.2020 the petitioner is in custody on alleged allegation of recovery of a country made pistol with one cartridge.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that he is on bail in ten cases pending against him since before. His implication is only due to animosity arising out of earlier ten cases.

Learned APP has opposed the prayer for bail.

Considering the rival submissions as also the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer for bail of the petitioner is allowed.

Let the petitioner above named be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of SDJM



Daudnagar, Aurangabad in Haspura PS Case No. 17 of 2020 subject to the following conditions:-

(i) That one of the bailors will be a close relative of the petitioner who will give an affidavit giving genealogy as to how he is related with the petitioner. The bailor will also undertake to inform the Court if there is any change in the address of the petitioner.

(ii) That the petitioner will be well represented on each date and if he fails to do so on two consecutive dates, his bail bond will be liable to be cancelled.
