2 16-04-2021 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State through virtual court proceeding.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to remove the defects within four weeks of resumption of normal court proceeding. In the eventuality of non-removal of defects within undertaken period, the office will place the matter before the Bench.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Rampur Chauram P.S. Case No.25 of 2020 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 304(B)/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per the prosecution case, the daughter of the informant has been killed by the petitioner and other accused persons by giving poison for the non-fulfillment of demand of dowry.



It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case due to local village politics and has not committed any offence as alleged in the FIR. Petitioner is the brother-in-law of the deceased, he is separate mace after his marriage and the husband of the deceased is already in jail. There is no any specific allegation against the petitioner rather the allegations are general and omnibus in nature. The deceased died due to illness (stomach pain) on the way to hospital. There is no eye-witness to the alleged occurrence. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent and has been languishing in custody since 27.05.2020.

Learned APP for the State opposed the bail petition.

Considering the facts aforesaid, the above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.C.J.M. 1st, Arwal in connection with Rampur Chauram P.S. Case No.25 of 2020.
