A.P.P for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in Darauli P.S. Case No. 06
of 2020, registered for the offence punishable under Section 392
of the Indian Penal Code.

As per the prosecution case, two unknown miscreants
having armed, entered into the SBI, CSP, Bauna Branch and on
the point of pistol, looted away cash of Rs. 1,83,000/-, HP
laptop, mobile phone.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
petitioner is not named in the FIR. Name of this petitioner has
transpired in this case on the basis of confessional statement of
co-accused Sobrati Miyan. No incriminating article has been
recovered from possession of this petitioner. One motorcycle



which is alleged to be recovered from the house of this petitioner does not belong to this petitioner. Moreover, other co-accused persons have been granted bail by this court. Petitioner is in custody since 30.05.2020.

Learned APP however, vehemently opposed the prayer for bail and submitted that black pulsor motorcycle which was used in the crime has been recovered from the house of this petitioner.

Considering the facts aforesaid, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner above-named on bail. Accordingly, the same is rejected.
