2 02-02-2021 Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to
remove the defects, as pointed out by the office, within a period
of four weeks.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under
Sections 25(1-AA)/25(1-B)a/26 of the Arms Act.

Allegation is that one country made pistol, two live
cartridges, two without barrel pistols, two iron made pistols, one
hammer and two wooden hammer are recovered.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
the petitioner is in custody since 09.06.2020. Charge sheet has
been submitted in this case. There is no allegation of tampering
of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner has



falsely been implicated in the present case. It is alleged that one country made pistol, two live cartridges, two without barrel pistols, two iron made pistols, one hammer and two wooden hammer are recovered from the shop. The shop in question does not belong to the petitioner. There is no compliance of Section 100 Cr.P.C.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gopalganj in connection with Manjhagarh P.S. case No.119 of 2020.
