“For issuance of appropriate writs/orders/directions in the nature of DECLARATION that provisions of the ‘Bihar Development of Ayurvedic and Unani Systems of Medicine Act, 1951’ (Act No. 31 of 1951) are ultra-vires inconsistent and contrary to the provisions of central legislation, namely, the ‘India Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (Act No. 48 of 1970) as repugnant and hence void; and for allied relief prayed for herein. ”

After the matter was heard for some time, learned



counsel for the petitioner, under instructions, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition reserving liberty to file a fresh petition, on the same and subsequent cause of action, if so required and desired.

Permission granted with liberty, as prayed for.

Present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn in the aforesaid terms.
