The learned Court below is also directed to conclude the trial at the earliest, preferably within a period of six months by hearing the matter on day-to-day basis, failing which, the learned Court below shall release the petitioner on bail on appropriate terms and conditions and submit the failure report to the Registrar(Vigilance) of this Court for appropriate action.
