3 06-12-2021 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to remove defect(s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks from today.

This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Nanpur P.S. Case No. 66 of 2020 for the offence punishable under Sections 363/365 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per the prosecution, deceased was called by the accused Nand Kishore Pandit on 01.03.2020 at about 7:30 P.M. and whereafter he was traceless. Subsequently, his dead body was recovered. During investigation, it has transpired that it is a case of honour killing and the petitioner along with other accused persons have killed the deceased.



Considering the nature of allegation, this is not a fit case for grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, this anticipatory bail application is dismissed. The petitioner is directed to surrender in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today.
