APP for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is expected to honor his undertaking given in the instant case for depositing the requisite court fee and to remove the defects as pointed out by office when called upon.

The petitioner seeks bail in Ahiyapur PS Case No.721 of 2019 instituted for the offence under Section 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

Three persons on a motorcycle have intercepted the informant. They have assaulted him and looted him of his belongings, including some cash.

It is submitted by the petitioner's counsel that he is not named in the First Information report. He is in custody since 01.06.2020. He has not been put on Test Identification Parade and it is a case of false implication based on his criminal antecedents. He is on bail in the other two cases pending against him since before.



The learned APP for the State has opposed the prayer for bail.

Considering the rival submissions, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, 9th Muzaffarpur, in connection with Ahiyapur PS Case No.721 of 2019, subject to the following conditions:-

(i) That one of the bailors will be a close relative of the petitioner who will give an affidavit giving genealogy as to how he is related with the petitioner. The bailor will also undertake to inform the Court if there is any change in the address of the petitioner.

(ii) That the petitioner will be well represented on each date and if he fails to do so on two consecutive dates, his bail bond will be liable to be cancelled.
