ORAL ORDER

3 15-03-2021 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Parbatta P.S. Case No.114 of 2020 registered for the offence
punishable under Section 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The instruction of the counsel appearing for the
informant is that the examination of witnesses has been
completed and at the trial the statement of the accused has
already been recorded.

In view of the aforesaid circumstance, Mr. N.K.
Agrawal, learned Senior Counsel representing the petitioner
submits that a direction should be given so that the trial is



expedited.

Considering the aforesaid circumstances, this application is rejected, however, with a direction to the trial court to expedite the hearing without granting undue adjournments.

This Court would expect that the petitioner's counsel would honour his undertaking in the instant proceedings regarding supply of the requisite court fee etc. within two weeks from the date he is called upon to do so by the office.
