The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Vishambharpur P.S. Case No. 135 of 2020 registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 30(a), 41(1) of the Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Allegation against the petitioner is that the petitioner
is the driver of the Wagon R Car.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is
no recovery from the conscious possession of the petitioner



rather 183.051 liters of foreign liquor has been recovered from the said vehicle. Petitioner is the driver of the said vehicle. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has got no any criminal antecedent mentioned in paragraph-3 of the bail petition. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is in jail custody since 04.09.2020.

Learned A.P.P. for the State opposed the bail petition.

Petitioner is agreed to deposit a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) in the PM Cares fund, bearing Account No.2121PM20202, IFSC Code: SBIN 0000691, SWIFT Code: SBININBB104, State Bank of India, New Delhi Main Branch, UPI ID: pmcares@sbi.
