2      12-01-2021                      The present petition has been filed for restoration of a  
  
petition bearing Criminal Misc. No. 441 of 2020, which had  
  
stood dismissed on account of non-compliance of the  
  
peremptory order dated 13.01.2020 regarding removal of the  
  
defects.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that  
though the defects have been removed, however, the Registry  
has considered the defects to have not been removed inasmuch  
as in the supplementary affidavit filed on behalf of the
