learned APP for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is expected

to honour his undertaking given in the instant case for

depositing the requisite court fee and to remove the

defects as pointed out by the office when called upon to



do so by the office.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 149, 323, 307, 447, 506, 379 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is alleged that these petitioners came at the door of the informant and assaulted the informant and other family members. The accused persons also snatched gold chain, earring and cash of rupees five thousands.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that accusations against the petitioners are omnibus and general. There is counter version of the occurrence also and there is no injury report on record. A statement has been made in para 3 of the petition that petitioners have no criminal antecedents.

In the facts and circumstance of the case, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of



four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousands) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, Saran at Chapra in connection with Derni P.S. Case No. 105 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
