8 17-08-2021 This case is being adjourned since 24.06.2021. Mr. Nachiketa Jha, learned counsel who was earlier representing the petitioner had informed this Court that he had no instruction to appear in this case as his client has taken away 'no-objection on his vakalatnama'. This Court adjourned the matter on 24.06.2021 expecting appearance of the petitioner through another learned counsel. On 05.07.2021 though the matter was listed but due to paucity of time it was not heard. Again on 06.07.2021 it was adjourned due to paucity of time. On 07.07.2021 the matter was adjourned giving a last opportunity to the petitioner to enter appearance through learned advocate. Again on 26.07.2021 the matter was adjourned giving last indulgence to the petitioner to enter appearance with a clear



understanding that on the next date if no one appears for the petitioner, this Court shall consider dismissing the application.

Learned counsel for the informant-O.P. No. 2 and learned A.P.P. for the State are present.

In the circumstances stated above, this application is dismissed for non-prosecution.
