2 01-11-2021 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to
remove the defect(s), as pointed out by the office, within a
period of eight weeks.

The petitioner is apprehending her arrest in Nadi P.S.
Case No. 138 of 2019 registered under Sections 304B, 201,
120(B) and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is of committing
torture and causing death of the victim due to non-fulfillment of
demand of dowry.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the
petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation
of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The



petitioner is mother-in-law of the deceased. She is separate in mess and property from husband of the deceased. She has got no concern with the alleged occurrence.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the Complaint Case/F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of twelve weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Smt. Ritu Kumari, learned Judicial Magistrate-Ist Class, Patna City in connection with Nadi P.S. Case No. 138 of 2019 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
