ORAL ORDER

2 26-11-2021 Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to remove the defects, as pointed out by the office, within a period of eight weeks.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State through virtual mode.

The present application has been filed for modification of the order dated 06.03.2020, passed in Cr. Misc. No. 66436 of 2019, by which the petitioner was granted anticipatory bail in connection with Bhagwanpur P.S. Case No. 114 of 2019, pending in the court of learned A.C.J.M.-I, Vaishali at Hajipur and the petitioner was directed to surrender in the court below within a period of twelve weeks and furnish bail bond.



Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that due to some unavoidable reasons the petitioner could not surrender in the court below well within time. It is further submitted that further time may be extended so that the petitioner could surrender in the court below.

Considering the submissions made on behalf of learned counsel for the petitioner and the grounds mentioned in the modification application, the period of surrender of the petitioner in the court below is extended for a further period of six weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order. The rest of the conditions stipulated in the order will be same.

The order dated 06.03.2020 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 66436 of 2019, is modified to the extent as indicated above.

The present application is disposed of.
