ORAL ORDER

4 23-11-2021 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP for the State.

The instant application for anticipatory bail has been filed by the petitioner apprehending his arrest in connection with Beur P.S. Case no. 202 of 2020 instituted for the offence under Sections 302, 307, 120B and 34 of the Indian Penal Code and section 27 of the Arms Act.

As per allegation in the FIR, six miscreants armed with pistol, entered into the office of the informant and started indiscriminate firing upon the persons, who were sitting there, resulting into bullet injuries to several persons. One of the injured, namely, Rajesh Kumar was brought dead to the hospital.



Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. He is a land broker. There is general and omnibus allegation against him. Specific allegation of threatening and making conspiracy is against co-accused Dina Yadav.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer of bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in the facts and circumstances of the case as stated above, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The petitioner is directed to surrender in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today and in the event of his arrest or surrender in connection with Beur P.S. Case no. 202 of 2020, G.R. No. 4455 of 2020, he will be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned ACJM-III, Patna subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
