APP for the State.

Counsel for the petitioner is directed to remove the
defect(s), as pointed out by the office, within a period of four
weeks.

The petitioner seeks bail in Rajoun P.S. case No.257
of 2018 corresponding to S.T. No.70 of 2019 registered under
Sections 498(A), 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code, pending in
the court of Additional Sessions Judge I, Banka.

The earlier bail application of the petitioner was
rejected vide Annexure 1 to the present application taking into
account that the petitioner is the husband of the deceased and
the postmortem report supports the allegations made in the
F.I.R.



A report was called for from the court below regarding the stage of trial. It has been reported that out of nine charge-sheeted witnesses, six witnesses have already been examined and the trial is likely to be concluded within a period of three months.

Considering the nature of accusation and the stage of the trial, I am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. The same is rejected.

The Trial Court is directed to take all necessary steps to conclude the trial preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order.
