3 08-12-2021 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 366(A),376(c),506/34 of the
Indian Penal Code and Section 4 of POCSO Act.

Petitioner is in custody since 24.07.2020.

Allegation is of commission of rape against a minor
girl.

The report of the learned Trial Judge reveals that
charges were framed on 10.02.2021, however, due to Covid
effect, prosecution witnesses have not been examined.

Let the learned Trial Judge conclude the trial within
nine months.

The Superintendent of Police, Nawada is directed to



ensure production of prosecution witnesses before the learned Trial Judge on each and every day fixed in the case.

Considering nature of allegation against the petitioner, I am not inclined to enlarge him on bail. Hence, prayer is refused in connection with Mahila P.S.Case No.20 of 2020 pending in the court of learned Addl. Sessions Judge-VI-cum-Special Judge, POCSO Act, Nawada.
