5 03-08-2021 Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to
remove all the defects pointed out by the Stamp Reporter within
four weeks after start of normal functioning of the Court.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and Ms.
Nirmala Kumari, learned APP for the State.

The petitioner in the present case is seeking regular
bail in connection with Sherghati (Dobhi) P.S. Case No. 426 of
2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147,
148, 149, 341, 323, 448, 307, 504, 506 of the Indian Penal Code
and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

As per the prosecution story, this petitioner had
pressed three bullets onto the chest of the injured Vikash Kumar.
The injury report corroborates the allegation against the
petitioner. He is the sole assailant and has got 10 criminal

antecedents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case. The petitioner is in custody since 03.12.2019.

Learned APP for the State has opposed the prayer for regular bail of the petitioner.

Considering the gravity of the offence alleged, the specific allegation and the criminal antecedent of the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to release the petitioner on bail.

The prayer for regular bail of the petitioner is, thus, refused.

Let the trial be expedited.
