2 26-10-2021 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Raghapur P.S. Case No. 94 of 2020 registered under Sections 304(B), 201 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in the present case. There is no specific allegation against the petitioners. Further he contended that petitioners are father-in-law, mother-in-law and unmarried sister-in-law of the deceased.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of the C.J.M., Vaishali at Hajipur in connection with Raghapur P.S. Case No. 94 of 2020, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
