ORAL ORDER

6 05-04-2021 It has been stated by learned A.C. to GA-8 that the Authorization Committee, constituted under the provisions of Transplantation of Human Organs and Tissues Act, 1994, has granted requisite no objection for kidney transplantation. The petitioner is the proposed recipient. The said no objection certificate is subject to the condition that kidney transplantation



shall be conducted in such medical institute, which has been granted due recognition by the Central Government or the State Government.

The petitioner is likely to be treated in Paras HMRI Hospital, Patna (respondents No. 11 and 12), which is being represented by Mr. Sandeep Kumar, learned counsel.

Since decision has been taken by the Authorization Committee, this application is disposed of with an observation that Paras HMRI Hospital shall proceed accordingly.
