learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioners are in custody in connection with Alipur P.S. Case No. 44 of 2020 for the offenses under Sections 147, 341, 323, 324, 307, 379, 504, 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioners is that these petitioners have assaulted the informant side.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners have no criminal antecedent. There is case and counter case on account of land dispute. The petitioners are in custody since 8.10.2020.



Considering the fact that the petitioners have no criminal antecedent and there is case and counter case on account of land dispute, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioners. Let the petitioners, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/-(Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-III, Gaya in connection with Alipur P.S. Case No. 44 of 2020.
