ORAL ORDER

3 17-03-2021 Heard the parties.

The petitioner is languishing in custody for the offence punishable under Sections 302 and 201/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioner is husband of the victim of dowry death. He is in custody since 21.07.2018. In the past, prayer for bail was refused on 15.05.2019 vide order at Annexure-1. The trial is still running at primary stage of prosecution evidence. Petitioner is ready to cooperate with the trial.

Considering the fact that there is no need for further detention of the petitioner as under trial prisoner, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20000/- (Twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court-below



where the case is pending in connection with Barachatti P.S.

Case No. 769 of 2017, with following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned Court-below.

(b) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.

(c) The petitioner shall not leave the country without permission of the trial Court.
