This is the second attempt of the petitioner to obtain
bail in connection with N.D.P.S. Case No. 18 of 2019 arising out
of F. No. NCB/PZU/V/13/2019 registered for the offence under
Sections 8, 2, 20, 25 & 29 of the N.D.P.S. Act.

Perused the report received from the learned District
and Sessions Judge, Incharge, West Champaran. Bettiah as
contained in letter no. 3379/2021. On perusal of the report, it
appears that the case is running for defence argument and the
learned trial court is expecting to conclude the trial within a
period of three months.
