court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge II-cum-Special Judge, Excise, Gopalganj in connection with Phulwaria P.S. Case No.17 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
