ORAL ORDER

2 15-09-2021 As prayed for, let the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners remove the defect(s), as pointed out by the office, within four weeks of starting of the Court proceeding in physical mode in normal course.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned A.P.P. for the State through Video Conferencing.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Sadar P.S. Case No. 257 of 2020, registered under Sections 304B/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The accusation is of killing the sister of the informant, Md. Manobar, by her husband and in-laws with the help of other relatives due to non-fulfillment of demand of



dowry.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that both petitioners are maternal uncle and maternal brother of Md. Salim, husband of the deceased, and they have falsely been implicated in the present case due to ulterior motive. Mr. Sanjeev Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioners, further, submits at bar that Md. Salim, husband of the deceased, is already in custody.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Purnia, in connection with Sadar P.S. Case No. 257 of 2020, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
