This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Madanpur P.S. Case No. 129 of 2020 for the offence punishable under Sections 341, 323, 504, 506, 379, 354, 427/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

In view of the fact that there is case and counter case from both the sides and dispute seems to be with regard to some shop, this anticipatory bail application is allowed.



Let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest/surrender within four weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Aurangabad, in connection with Madanpur P.S. Case No. 129 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
