the petitioner remove the defect(s), as pointed out by the office,  
within four weeks of starting of the Court proceeding in  
physical mode in normal course.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the  
learned A.P.P. for the State through Video Conferencing.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection  
with Marhaura (Gaura O.P.) P.S. Case No. 364 of 2018,  
registered under Section 366 of the Indian Penal Code, pending  
in the court of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-VIII, Saran  
at Chapra.

The accusation is of kidnapping of wife and  
children of the informant, Ajay Singh, by the petitioner.



Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case and the nature of allegation against the petitioner, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to him.
