This application for grant of anticipatory bail arises out of Kathaiya P.S. Case No. 165 of 2019, registered for the offence under Sections 272, 273, 34 of the Indian Penal Code and section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition & Excise Act, 2016.

In view of the fact that prima facie a case under the Excise Act, is made out against this petitioner, this application for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is not maintainable in view of Full Bench decision of this Court rendered in the case of Ram Vinay Yadav vs. The State of Bihar reported in 2019(2) P.L.J.R. 1089 (F.B.)



Accordingly, this anticipatory bail application is
dismissed as not maintainable.
