The petitioner seeks bail in anticipation of his
arrest in connection with Bechhwara P. S. Case No. 176
of 2020, dated 26.08.2020 (G. R. No. 843 of 2020),
instituted for the offences under Section 30 (a) of the
Bihar Prohibition and Excise (Amendment) Act, 2018.

It is alleged in the F.I.R. that from the
courtyard of the house of the petitioner, 17.625 litres of
liquor has been recovered.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has



submitted that he is a person of clean antecedents and the house is not in his exclusive possession.

However, for the reason of recovery of liquor from the courtyard of the house of the petitioner, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to him.

The prayer for anticipatory bail is rejected.

However, if the petitioner surrenders before the court below and seeks bail, that shall be considered on its own merits, without being prejudiced by the fact that the present petition on his behalf has not been entertained by this Court.
