2 16-03-2021 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State through virtual court proceeding.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to
remove the defects, as pointed out by the office, within four
weeks of resumption of normal court proceeding. In the
eventuality of non-removal of defects within undertaken
period, the office will place the matter before the Bench.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Excise
Case No.125 of 2020, registered for the offence punishable
under Section 30(a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

100 liters of country made liquor is said to have been
recovered from the bike and bag of the petitioner.



It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that no incriminating article has been recovered from the conscious physical possession of the petitioner. It is further submitted that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case as he has no concern either with the seized liquor or the place of recovery or any trade of liquor and the said motorcycle does not belong to him. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para-3 of the present petition and has been languishing in custody since 14.08.2020.

Petitioner is agreed to deposit a sum of Rs. 10,000.00 (Rupees Ten Thousand) in the PM Cares fund, bearing Account No.2121PM20202, IFSC Code: SBIN 0000691, SWIFT Code: SBININBB104, State Bank of India, New Delhi Main Branch, UPI ID : pmcares@sbi.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of case, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below, in connection with Excise Case No.125 of 2020.

The bail bonds of the petitioner shall be accepted by the learned Court below on showing receipt of deposit of



Rs.10,000.00 (Rupees Ten Thousand) in the PM Cares fund.
