Heard learned counsel for the parties.

This application for grant of anticipatory bail arises out of Govindpur P.S. Case No. 189 of 2019 registered for the offence under Section 30(a) and 37 (c) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

In view of the fact that *prima facie* a case under the Excise Act, is made out against the petitioners, this application for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners is not maintainable in view of Full Bench decision of this Court rendered in the case of ***Ram Vinay Yadav vs. The State of Bihar*** reported in ***2019(2) P.L.J.R. 1089 (F.B.)***.



Accordingly, this anticipatory bail application is
dismissed as not maintainable.
