2 15-11-2021 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the State.

Counsel for the petitioners is directed to remove the defect(s), as pointed out, by the office, within a period of four weeks.

The present application has been filed for modification of the order dated 14.07.2020 passed in Cr.Misc.No. 20734 of 2020, by which the petitioners were granted provisional anticipatory bail in connection with Sidhwalia P.S. case No.188 of 2019, pending in the



court of A.C.J.M. VI, Gopalganj.

It is submitted on behalf of the counsel for the petitioners that due to some unavoidable reasons the petitioners could not surrender in the court below well within time. It is further prayed on behalf of the counsel for the petitioners that further time may be extended so that the petitioners could surrender in the court below.

Considering the submissions made on behalf of the learned counsel for the petitioners and the grounds mentioned in the modification application, the period of surrender of the petitioners in the court below is extended for a further period of eight weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order. The rest of the conditions stipulated in the order will be same.

The order dated 14.07.2020 passed in Cr.Misc.No. 20734 of 2020, is modified to the extent as indicated above.

The modification application is, accordingly, allowed.
