ORAL ORDER

2 01-09-2021 As prayed for, let the learned counsel appearing for

the petitioner remove the defect(s), as pointed out by the office,

within four weeks of starting of the Court proceeding in

physical mode in normal course.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State through Video Conferencing.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Special (Excise) Case No. 162 of 2019, registered under
Section 30(a) of the Bihar Excise Act, 2016, pending in the
court of learned Additional Sessions Judge-II-cum-Special
Judge (Excise), Saharsa.

The accusation is of recovery of two litre country
made liquor from the house of the petitioner and six litre



country made liquor from the ditch near the house of the petitioner.

Taking into consideration the alleged illicit country made liquor, which is said to be recovered from the house of the petitioner, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to him. Accordingly, his prayer for grant of anticipatory bail stands rejected. The petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial court within four weeks and pray for regular bail, which would be considered by the trial court in accordance with law without being prejudiced by the order of this Court.
