**CORAM: HONOURABLE MR. JUSTICE RAJEEV RANJAN PRASAD
ORAL ORDER**

4 13-04-2021 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

Petitioner in the present case is seeking regular bail in
connection with Turkauliya P.S. Case No.648 of 2019 registered
for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 324, 326, 307,
302, 120B and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this
case due to land dispute. Learned counsel submits that there
is no specific allegation of assault against this petitioner and his
name has been brought in this case merely on suspicion. It is
submitted that the petitioner is in custody since 21.09.2019
without there being any cogent material against him.



Learned APP for the State is present and has opposed the prayer for regular bail of the petitioner.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case wherein there is specific allegation that this petitioner and the co-accused had surrounded the deceased and open fire on him, the allegations getting support from the postmortem report which shows multiple fire-arm injuries causing death of the brother of the informant, considering the seriousness of the allegations, the materials on the record and the criminal antecedent pointing out against this petitioner, this Court is not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The prayer for bail is, thus, refused.

Let the trial be expedited.
