3 01-12-2021 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned
counsel for the informant and learned APP for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to
remove the defects within four weeks. In the eventuality of non-
removal of defects within undertaken period, the office will
place the matter before the Bench.

This is the second attempt of the petitioner to
approach before this Court for bail. Earlier, vide order dated
06.01.2021 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 30210 of 2020, the prayer
for bail of the petitioner was rejected with a direction to the
learned Court below to conclude the trial within six months and
if the trial is not concluded within six months, the petitioner
may renew his prayer for bail.



It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that out of six witnesses four have been examined. It is further submitted that similarly situated co-accused has been granted bail by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide Annexure-3 to this application.

Considering the facts aforesaid, the above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Danapur P.S. Case No.433 of 2017, subject to the following conditions :

- (1) One of the bailors will be his own blood relative, preferably, father, mother, brother, sister and/or his wife.
- (2) The petitioner shall not indulge himself in any similar offence till conclusion of the trial.
- (3) The petitioner shall remain physically present in court on each and every date during trial and in the event of failure on two consecutive dates without sufficient reasons, his bail bonds shall be liable to be cancelled by the learned court concerned.
- (4) The petitioner shall co-operate with the investigation,



if not already concluded and make himself available and when so required and in case of failure, the State shall be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail.

(5) The petitioner will mark his attendance in the local police station in first week of every month till conclusion of trial, failing which the prosecution will be at liberty to move cancellation of his bail bond.
