2 17-12-2021 Heard learned counsel for the parties through video conferencing.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offence under Section 30(a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

80 liters of Mahua liquor has been recovered from the motorcycle of the petitioner.

It is submitted on behalf of petitioner that nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Petitioner claims clean antecedent and he is in custody since 13.08.2021. Investigation is complete.

Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the bail petition.

Considering the nature of allegation, clean antecedent



and period of custody, the bail petition of petitioner is allowed.
Let the above named petitioner be released on bail on furnishing
bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the
like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional
Sessions Judge II cum Special Judge, Excise, Jehanabad in
connection with Parasi P.S. Case No. 47 of 2021 (Excise Act
Case No. 678 of 2021).
