2 09-04-2021 Let the defects be removed within two weeks of the
start of the physical Court.

Heard the parties in virtual Court.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 457,380 of the Indian Penal
Code.

Submission is that FIR of the occurrence of theft was
lodged after 16 days of the occurrence. Name of the petitioner
surfaced in the confessional statement of co-accused.
Investigation of the case is already complete.

Considering facts aforesaid, let the petitioner, above
named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of
Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like
amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where



the case is pending in connection with Manihari Police Station
Case No.195 of 2020 with following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be resident of territorial
jurisdiction of the learned Court-below.

(b) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the trial
of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to
cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.

(c) The petitioner shall not leave the country without
permission of the trial Court.
