2 10-12-2021 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with Minapur P.S. Case No. 377 of 2020 registered under Section 366(A)/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in the present case. On perusal of Annexure nos. 2 and 3, it appears that the victim girl is a major and nothing has come against the petitioners in her statement recorded under Section 164 Cr. P.C. She specifically stated that she has married with one Raju Kumar on her own will. Further

he submits that petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of C.J.M., Muzaffarpur in connection with Minapur P.S. Case No. 377 of 2020, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
