APP for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is expected to honour his undertaking to remove the defects as pointed out by the office when called upon to do so by the office.

The instant application for anticipatory bail has been filed by the petitioners apprehending their arrest in connection with Barhaiya P.S. Case no. 185 of 2020 instituted for the offence under Sections 323, 341, 447, 308 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per allegation in the FIR, petitioners have abused and assaulted the informant with iron rod on his head.



Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners has submitted that petitioners are innocent and have been falsely implicated in this case due to dirty village politics. General and omnibus allegations have been levelled against the petitioners. There is case and counter case between the parties.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer of bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in the facts and circumstances of the case as stated above, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioners on bail. The petitioners are directed to surrender in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today and in the event of their arrest or surrender in connection with Barahiya P.S. Case no. 185 of 2020, they will be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Lakhisarai subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
