This application for anticipatory bail arises out of
Bairiya P.S. Case No. 32 of 2020 for the offence punishable
under Sections 341, 323, 354-B/34 of the Indian Penal Code and
under Section 12 / 17 of the POCSO Act.

In view of the fact that the allegations made against
these petitioners are general and omnibus and co-accused Sajan
Kumar has been granted regular bail, this application is allowed.
Let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their
arrest/surrender within four weeks from today in the Court
below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.



10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge- VII-cum- Special Judge, POCSO, West Champaran, Bettiah, in connection with Bairiya P.S. Case No. 32 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
