2 10-12-2021 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Gandhi Maidan P.S. Case No. 91 of 2020 registered under
Section 30(a) of the Excise Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been
implicated in the present case. On perusal of seizure list, it
appears that nothing has been recovered from the possession of
the petitioner. Further he contended that petitioner is not the
owner of the alleged vehicle and he has no concern with the
recovered foreign liquor. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the
case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the

event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of the Special Judge, Excise, Patna in connection with Gandhi Maidan P.S. Case No. 91 of 2020, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
