6 23-02-2021 The present writ petition has been filed for directing the respondent-State to pay the retiral benefits of the petitioner, who has superannuated on 31.03.2017, while working as Assistant Engineer with the Minor Water Resources Division, Jamui.

It appears that during the interregnum period, most of the retiral dues have stood paid, however, it has been informed by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the leave encashment amount for few days, G.P.F. amount for few days and interest on account of delayed payment of retiral dues have not been paid.



Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed of as not pressed, however, with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondent no.2 for his subsisting grievance, if any, which shall be redressed by the respondent no.2 in accordance with law within a period of three weeks from the date, the petitioner approaches the respondent no.2.
