2 15-11-2021 Let the defects, if any, be removed within four weeks
of the complete start of the physical Court.

Heard the parties.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 30(a), (c) and (d) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Petitioner was not there at the time of recovery of liquor from an abandoned house. However allegation is that the recovered liquor was of the petitioner and others. Petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. Prosecution report has been submitted without proper investigation of the case.

Since there is no direct material on petitioner's involvement in the act alleged, let the petitioner, above named,



in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/- (rupees twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending in connection with Excise Case No. 973 of 2020, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as subject to the following conditions:

(a) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.

(b) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned Court-below

(c) The petitioner shall not leave the country without permission of the trial Court.
