Counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to
withdraw the present application on behalf of the petitioner



No.2, namely, Golu Singh, as the petitioner No.2 has been taken into judicial custody.

Permission is accorded.

The application filed on behalf of petitioner No.2 is dismissed as withdrawn.

The present application has been filed on behalf of the petitioners No.1 and 3 to 6 for modification of the order dated 29.06.2020 passed in Cr.Misc.No.13970 of 2020, by which the petitioners No.1 and 3 to 6 were granted anticipatory bail in connection with Majhagarh P.S. case No.331 of 2019, pending in the court of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gopalganj.

It is submitted on behalf of the counsel for the petitioners No.1 and 3 to 6 that due to some unavoidable reasons the petitioners No.1 and 3 to 6 could not surrender in the court below well within time. It is further prayed on behalf of the counsel for the petitioners No.1 and 3 to 6 that further time may be extended so that the petitioners No.1 and 3 to 6 could surrender in the court below.

The order dated 29.06.2020 passed in Cr.Misc.No.13970 of 2020, is modified to the extent as indicated above.

The modification application is, accordingly, allowed.
